Ministries

There will also be a table set up on Sunday, September 18 in the Social Hall, as well as at the Parish picnic on Sunday, September 25 for families to update their information.

Topics of Discussion

Good Stuff Sale – November 5 is the date for the sale. A committee will be formed in the next 2 weeks to help coordinate the sale. People are needed to help advertise, both with flyers and online. Credit cards will be accepted this year. Fribronia volunteered to head up this committee. The times for dropping off sale items are: The times will be from 6:00pm to 8:00pm on Wednesdays, 3:30pm to 4:30pm on Saturdays, and 9:30am to 10:15am on Sundays, beginning Wednesday, September 21 and run through Wednesday, November 2. There will be no drop off time on Sunday, September 25, the day of the Parish picnic. Items of clothing that will be accepted are purses, hats, and scarves. Jewelry will also be accepted.

Picnic – The date for the picnic is Sunday, September 25. The Liturgy will be at the church and the picnic will follow at Honeycutt Park. The pavilion will be available to us until 2pm and it may be extended until 3pm if needed. The Knights will be asked for their help to bring tables and games.
